Include an explanation of the outcomes, project management methodology, and what contributed to the projects success. (10 points)



3. Identification of benefits. Communities will explain how the Blueprint will impact their community and evaluate the community benefits. Communities will provide an explanation for any financial, economic, health, aesthetics, etc. benefits their community will receive as a result from the Blueprint- cost savings, improved air quality, reduction of green house gas emissions, etc. (15 points)
